#### **ANNEX 1**

The annexes to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 792/2012 are amended as follows:

- (1) Annex I, 'Permit/Certificate', is amended as follows:
  - (a) in point 13 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to "1 Original', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006<sup>1</sup>, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
  - (b) in point 13 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to '2 Copy for the holder', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
  - (c) in point 13 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to '3 Copy for return by customs to the issuing authority', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
  - (d) in point 13 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to '4 Copy for the issuing authority' and to '5 Application', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
- (2) Annex III, 'Travelling-exhibition certificate', is amended as follows:
  - (a) in point 14 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to 'Original', the following row is added:

- (b) in point 14 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to 'Copy for the issuing authority' and to 'Application', the following row is added:
  - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
- (3) Annex V, 'Certificate Not for use outside the European Union', is amended as follows:
  - (a) in point 9 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to 'Original', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".
  - (b) in point 9 of the 'Instructions and explanations' referring to 'Copy for the issuing authority' and to 'Application', the following row is added:
    - "Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".

- 5. Only applies where the country from which the specimens are imported is not the country of origin.
- 6. Description must be as precise as possible.
- 9. Use one of the following codes to indicate the source:
  - W Specimens taken from the wild
  - R Specimens of animals reared in a controlled environment, taken as eggs or juveniles from the wild, where they would otherwise have had a very low probability of surviving to adulthood
  - D Annex A animals bred in captivity for commercial purposes in operations included in the Register of the CITES Secretariat, in accordance with Resolution Conf. 12.10 (Rev. CoP15), and Annex A plants artificially propagated for commercial purposes in accordance with Chapter XIII of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, as well as parts and derivatives thereof

  - O Pre-convention (1)
  - U Source unknown (must be justified)
  - X Specimens taken in the marine environment not under the jurisdiction of any State
  - Y Plant specimens obtained from assisted production, which are considered not to be "artificially propagated" as set out in Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, and also not considered to be taken from the wild because they are propagated or planted in an environment with some level of human intervention for the purpose of plant production".

- 10. The scientific name must be the name used in Annexes C or D to Regulation (EC) No 338/97.
- 11. Enter III for species listed in Appendix III to CITES.
- 13. Enter the letters (C or D) of the Annex to Regulation (EC) No 338/97 in which the species is listed.
- 14. The importer has to submit the signed original (form 1) and 'copy for the importer' (form 2), where appropriate together with CITES Appendix III documents from the (re-)exporting country to the customs office of introduction into the Union.

15. The customs office shall send the stamped original (form 1) to the management authority of his country and return the stamped 'copy for the importer' (form 2) to the importer or his authorised representative

CoP15), and Annex A plants artificially propagated for commercial purposes in accordance with Chapter XIII of Regulation (EC) No 865/2006, as well as parts and derivatives thereof

- 11. Enter III for species listed in Appendix III to CITES.
- 13. Enter the letters (C or D) of the Annex to Regulation (EC) No 338/97 in which the species is listed.
- 14. The importer has to submit the signed original (form 1) and 'copy for the importer' (form 2), where appropriate together with CITES Appendix III documents from the (re-)exporting country to the customs office of introduction into the Union.

15. The customs office shall send the stamped original (form 1) to the management authority of his country and return the stamped 'copy for the importer' (form 2) to the importer or his authorised representative.
